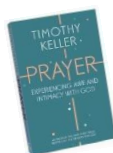

## A timely reminder

21 June 2015

Is it a new phenomenon of being 'time poor'? Yet that seems to be the answer of a lot of people when we ask how they are going – busy, rushed, never enough time...

I was reminded this week, when reading *Prayer* by Tim Keller, (our book of the term) of the importance of slowing down and meditating upon God's word and the importance of this for our prayer life. He writes "While deep experiences of the presence and power of God can happen in innumerable ways, the ordinary way for going deeper spiritually in prayer is through meditation on Scripture" (p146). He uses Psalm one to help us to grasp this. I encourage you to meditate on that Psalm sometime this week.

In drinking deep from the truths of scripture we are like the tree planted by streams of water. We find all we need for the seasons of life and in all the seasons we are able to prosper.



I encourage you as you give time day by day in reading the Bible to take it slowly and ponder what God is saying. Drink deep and be satisfied. Drink deep and be refreshed. Drink deep and be inspired.
