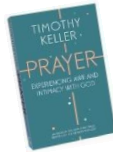

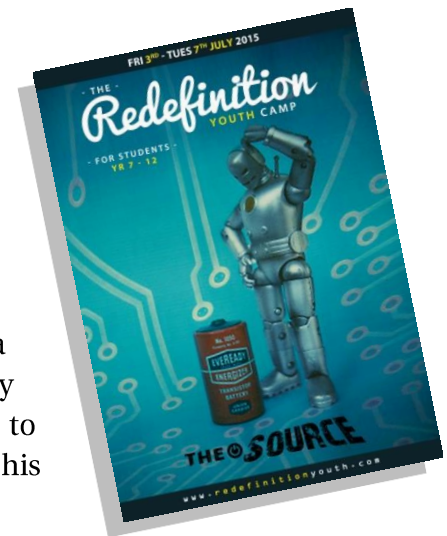
## Lives being transformed this weekend
